Intake screening	P2W team trained community staff on CAMERA as a tool to help select participants. Community staff members carried out intake screening, including intake interviews and CAMERA assessments.
Skills training	Eight weeks of integrated skills training and work experience were delivered. This included Skills for Success and occupational skills and safety training (Facilities Maintenance Program).
Work experience	Eight weeks of work experience were provided in which participants who demonstrated readiness for employment renovated a building in the community.
